

**What problems do B Level ELL students say they have in their classes:**

1. When told a process
  - a. Didn't understand the explanation
2. Too much information at once.
3. I know what the question is asking me, but how do I answer it?
4. Hard to find the information that I need.
5. Too much work, overwhelming, can't finish it all.
6. I kind of get it, but:
  - a. When I ask and the teacher explains it more, I get more confused.
  - b. They don't use words that I know.
7. It is like they are speaking a different language.
8. They talk too fast.
9. It is hard to hear from a tape and understand anything.
10. I need more help on how to write.
11. I don't understand the homework, even when they explain it.

**What B Level ELL students say their teachers do to help them (or what they can do).**

1. Give me examples.
2. Start the work to give me an idea how to do it and so I can see what you want from me.
3. Do an easy example and give me the harder ones to do.
4. Have me redo something when I don't get it.
5. Correct my reading when I am reading aloud.
6. Give me an example on a piece of paper in front of me to use.
