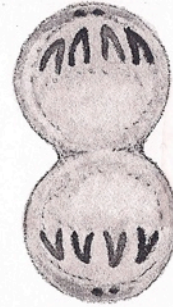

The parent cell gets ready to divide when each chromosome in the nucleus makes an exact copy of itself.

The nucleus gets ready to divide

The two chromosome copies line up in the center of the cell.

The copies of each chromosome separate. Each set goes to one side of the cell.

The cytoplasm pinches together in the middle of the cell. The parent cell divides, making two new daughter cells.
