



Adventure Park

As one of our busiest parks, you'll not only find our Parks & Recreation Department offices located here, but a 17,000 square-foot skate park, playground, basketball courts, and a variety of recreation programs held inside and outside for all to enjoy. You'll also find our two on-site gazebo's at this location, great for hosting a picnic or small gathering.

Arbor Ridge Park

Visitors can step onto our tennis courts for a competitive game of tennis, play the day away on our handicapped accessible playground, or fly a kite as the winds blow through the open green space at Arbor Ridge Park. One of our newest parks, this is a great place for recreational play the entire family can enjoy.

Beechwood Park

Adjacent to Adventure Park, Beechwood Park is a heavily wooded nature preserve offering great opportunities for hiking or educational programming.

Library Park

Athletic fields make up a significant portion of this park with wide open spaces within a short distance from a well-established gathering of native Ohio trees. Mixed in are a variety of court games and a playground for kids of all ages to enjoy. The local library is also located in this park if you're looking for an interesting book to check-out before biking back home.

Meadowview Park

Nestled in the heart of the Ashmoore subdivision, Meadowview Park boasts a winding forest trail, a leisurely fishing pond, and playground. The cattails surrounding the pond offer not only a good hiding place for the many animals that call this park home, but a serene backdrop for a relaxing afternoon picnic.

Murphy Park

Once the location of car races, the first Delaware County Fair, and a party barn, you'll find Murphy Park a quiet site featuring two playgrounds, horse shoe and bocce ball areas, as well as a new summer house available to rent for birthday parties, reunions, or cookouts among the mature trees.

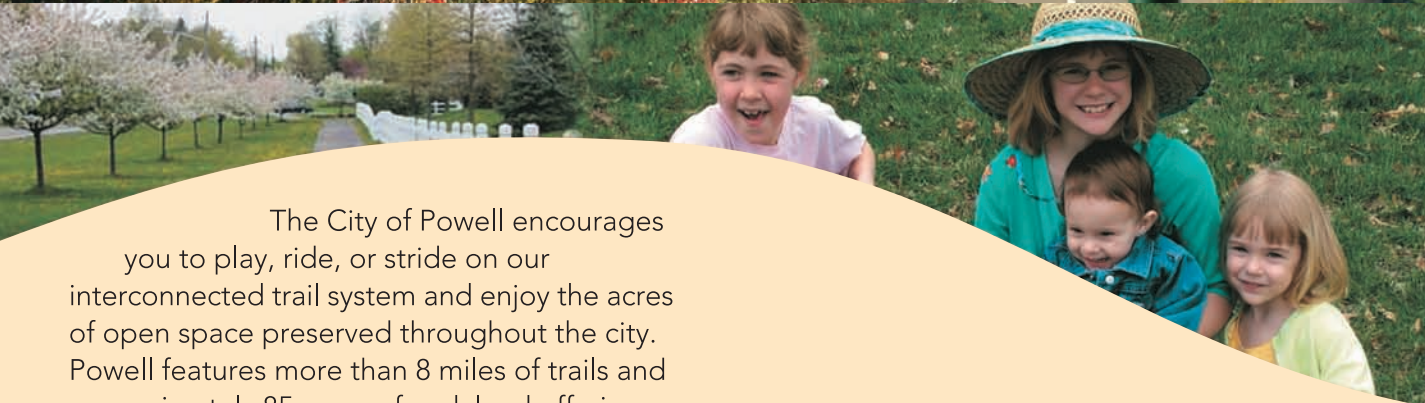
Oak Park

Named for a two hundred year old swamp oak tree, residents can enjoy a stroll through this quiet nature preserve near the southern edge of Powell.

Village Green Park

Located in the heart of the City, Village Green Park has something for everyone! Events such as the annual Powell Festival, are held here, along with children making waves in the ever-popular splash pad, and you can often hear music filling the air from our concert amphitheater. Truly the gathering place for the community, this park is alive with activity all year long. The municipal offices and police department are also adjacent to the park for those needing to do business with the City.

Powell features more than 8 miles of trails and approximately 85 acres of park land offering numerous opportunities for walking, wildlife viewing, jogging or simply enjoying the outdoors.

As you journey along the pathways, you'll likely discover one of Powell's eight-award-winning parks, our vibrant historic downtown shopping district, or a neighborhood pond being visited by a great blue heron. Some portions of our pathways also use neighborhood streets while others meander around many of Powell's most scenic park areas. Wherever you are peddling to, our pathways make it easy to get where you want to go.

Our shared pathways and parks are special points of pride and we hope you use this guide to help you plan your next route through our community or to explore our open spaces and natural areas that make Powell a special place to live. 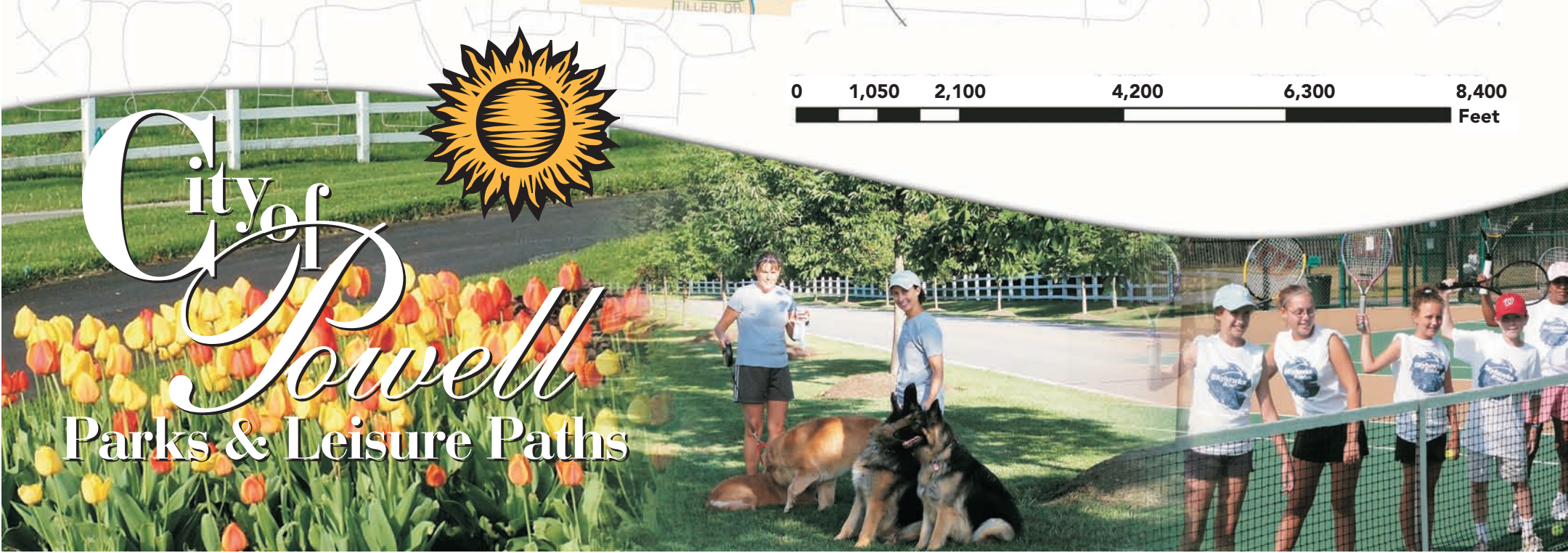
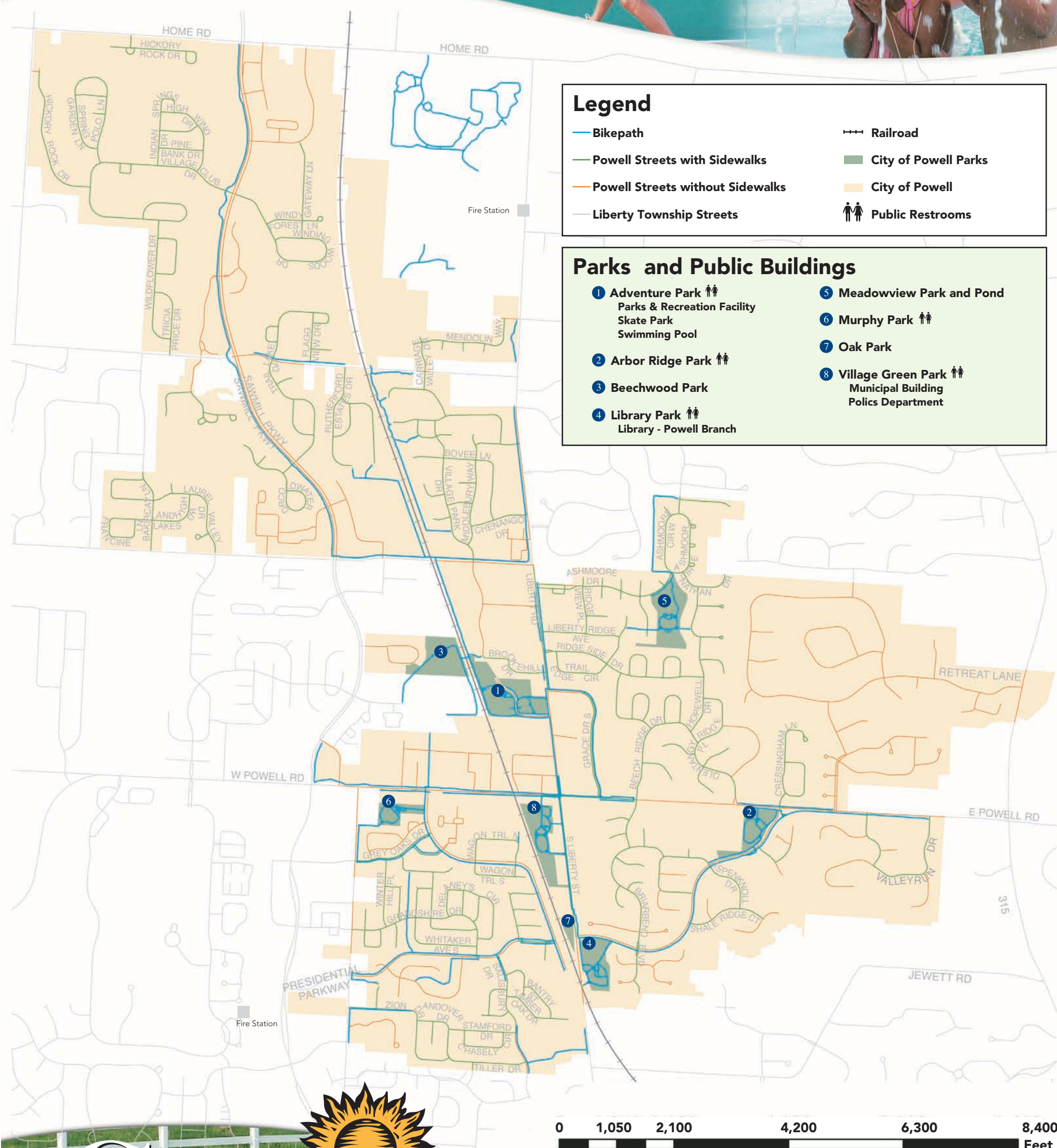
