## Cell Phone Policy

### 2013–2014

Student cell phones may be used in the hallways during class changes, during lunch, as well as before and after school. Student cell phones must be stored out of site and powered off (not just in silent or vibrate mode) during class time (including study hall). Students in violation of this policy will receive the following consequences:

#### ***First Offense:***

The student's cell phone is turned into the student's assistant principal. The student must see his/her assistant principal at the end of the school day to receive a **One Hour Detention** and retrieve his/her cell phone. We are no longer going to require the parent to pick up the cell phone on the first offense.

#### ***Second Offense:***

The student's cell phone is turned into the student's assistant principal. The student must see their assistant principal at the end of the school day to receive a **Wednesday School**. The parent/guardian must come to school to retrieve the cell phone.

#### ***Third Offense:***

The student's cell phone is turned into the student's assistant principal. The student must see his/her assistant principal at the end of the school day to receive a **Wednesday School and parent pick up**. The parent/guardian must come to school to retrieve the cell phone.

#### ***Fourth Offense:***

The student's cell phone is turned into the student's assistant principal. The student must see his/her assistant principal at the end of the school day to receive **further discipline and parent pick up**. The parent/guardian must come to school to retrieve the cell phone.
