- Covers the East African Community plus Sudan





How is the baseline being established?


- Survey of biomass used for traditional stoves

- Efficiency of the ICS




What is the stove dissemination approach?

- ICSEA encourages the Supplier Organisations * to set up a maintenance scheme

*CPA implementers are ICS 'Supplier Organisations' – they can be manufacturers, importers, distributors etc.




How are monitoring and testing done?

- ICSEA is not CER owner
- SOs will be committed to ensure that
 - Women can buy better stoves at a lower price, get stove maintenance, & some carbon cash!

How can a stove organization benefit from the programme?

Criteria for inclusion

- The ICSs employed by the CPA prove a minimum of 25% fuel efficiency consumption.
- The ICSs are designed for use of (i) firewood or (ii) charcoal.
- The ICS employed by the CPA are either be imported or locally manufactured.
- The ICSs are (i) transportable or (ii) fixed built in models.
- The CPA acknowledges the CER's ownership by stove purchasers and is committed to a fair distribution of ICSs earnings.
- The CPA will be located in Burundi, Rwanda, Uganda, Tanzania, Kenya or South Sudan.

Mission/Stated Goal

- Access to Carbon Finance for ICS
Supplier Organisations across East Africa
- Fair trade features are expected from Supplier Organisations in the way that carbon income is shared with stove users
- Supplier Organisations are free to market their CERs
no CME monopoly
