Explain **what** it tells us about each **character**.

4. Describe an **important relationship** between two characters in each text.
Explain **why** each relationship is **important**.

5. Describe what a **character learns about him or herself** in each text.
Explain **how** this happens in **each** text.

6. Describe **at least one technique of structure** used in **each** text.
Explain **why** each technique is important.
(This could include use of links, sequence, layout or any other interesting technique the writer has used)
