Instructions for Out-of-Class Composition I:

1. Write an original, academic 175-to-200-word paragraph on one of the following topics.
Narrow down the topic as necessary.
2. Choose a topic from the following:
 - a) Effects of sports (benefits for people)
 - b) Causes (or) Effects of water pollution
 - c) Causes (or) effects of global warming
 - d) Effects of watching Animé obsessively
 - e) Causes (or) Effects of consumerism
3. Use the rhetorical pattern of ***cause-effect***. Make sure you include clear causes and/or effects of the topic chosen.
4. **Underline the topic sentence of your paragraph inside the composition.**
5. **Do not use any type of outside sources to support your ideas.**
6. Write a formal outline and hand it in.
7. Write a draft, including a clear, well-focused topic sentence and a sound conclusion.
8. Revise the paragraph in terms of coherence, clarity, and logic of ideas to make sure it is reader-centered.
10. Edit your paragraph in terms of grammar, vocabulary, punctuation, and spelling.
11. Hand in the final corrected version and its outline printed to your professor.
