## **I. Print Materials**

Click on **SEARCH** tab.

[Student Resources in Context](#): allows you to search for reference books, magazines, newspapers, primary documents, and multimedia files on your topic.

Click on “Advanced Search,” then type your search words in the search boxes.

Be sure to check use the links on the left to narrow your search by source type: Reference, Magazines, Newspapers, Academic Journals, Primary Sources, etc.

[Opposing Viewpoints in Context](#): allows you to search Opposing Viewpoints series books to find pro/con articles on controversial topics. Many titles are also available in our library for checkout.

Be sure to check use the links on the left to narrow your search by source type: Viewpoints, Images, Reference, News, Statistics, Magazines, Academic Journals, Primary Sources, Websites, etc.

[Issues and Controversies](#): allows you to search pro/con articles on controversial topics.

Be sure to check out all tabs: Featured Articles, Editorial Cartoons, By the Numbers, Reference Shelf.

[Congressional Digest’s Pro and Con Online](#) gives you access to the archives of *Congressional Digest*, *Supreme Court Debates*, and *International Debates*.
