

Embedding An MP3 Player Using Dreamweaver

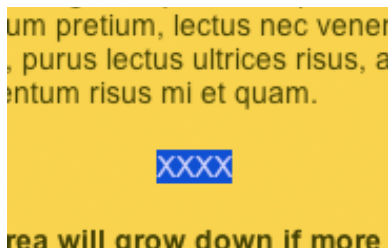
If you have a podcast, original or copyright-free music, you can embed the audio file into your .html page with a player. This tutorial requires you to edit the HTML of your page.

STEP 1: Move/Save your MP3 file into your project folder

STEP 2: Go to Dreamweaver and open the webpage that will display the audio file.

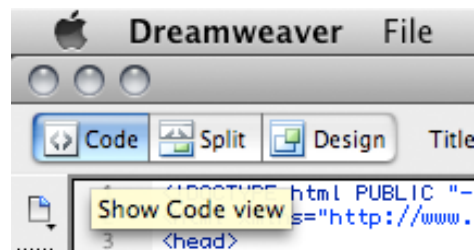
STEP 3:

Decide where you want the player to be and type “XXXX”. This will help you easily find your location when looking at the code. Select the text after you type it.



STEP 4:

Click on “Code” on the top left-hand side of your screen. You will see the HTML that makes up your webpage.



STEP 6:

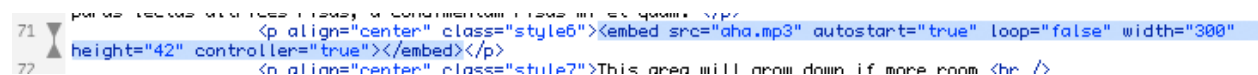
Launch the application Text Edit or Note Pad. We use these applications to type out code before inserting it into the HTML. It makes it easier to read and edit.

File > Copy the following text and paste it into the text document:

```
<embed src="aha.mp3" autostart="false" loop="false" width="300" height="42" controller="true" bgcolor="#FFFFFF"></embed>
```

Change “your-file-name” to the name of your file. Change the “#FFFFFF” to match the colors from your website. **Select all of the text, File > Copy**

STEP 7: Return to Dreamweaver. Scroll down until you see the “XXXX”. Make sure it is selected. **File > Paste** to replace the XXXX with the embed code.



Step 8: Save your page and **File > Preview in Browser**
