

WEBPAGE TUTORIAL

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Including details from Unit 6: Preparation & Organization This tutorial can be done with any editor on either platform.

1 Create A Folder On The Desktop

All files will live here.

All files in folder get uploaded to
the TQNYC server.

2 Get 2 Images from Pics4Learning.com

All file names should be
lowercase, no spaces
or punctuation.

3 Create “index” page with Web Authoring software

Either .htm OR .html, depending
on the software you’re using.

The first page of every site is
always named index.

Add color, image and 3 cell table.
“About” “TQNYC” “E-mail Me”

4 Create “about” page *It’s your turn to test what you just learned!*

Each html page and image are
separate files that work together
to create the website.

Just like the “index” page add an
image, words and a table with
these words in the cell:
“Home” “TQNYC” “E-mail Me”

5 Hyperlink Pages To Each Other

Internal hyperlinks connect
pages within your folder together:
about.htm links to index.htm and
vice versa.

External hyperlinks take the
user out of your site and to any
other website you choose.

Spelling counts!

6 Upload to TQNYC server

Log in at tqnyc.org with your
TeamID and Password

Each file used for your site must
get uploaded.

If your first try was unsuccessful,
check that all files were uploaded,
file names are correct in the
hyperlinks.
