All entries must include a Critical Thinking Summary that answers the below-noted questions.

1. What problem did you intend to solve?
2. Who will benefit from your entry?
3. What unique value does your entry offer to users?
4. What type(s) of research did you conduct?
5. Did you conduct your own research? For example, did you implement a survey, a poll, an experiment, or a field study? Did you conduct interviews with experts? Did you do something else?
6. Did you use information that was created and published by another person? What/whose work was used, and did you credit them appropriately?
7. Does your entry effectively solve the problem? How did you test your solution?
8. What impact did this project have on your team? What did you learn by participating?

Additional Self-Answered Questions for Evaluation:

Communication Skills

1. Is your entry clearly organized and presented?
2. Is all text polished (i.e., clearly written with correct grammar, punctuation and spelling) and in your own words?
3. Are resources not authored by you credited appropriately?

Technology Skills:

1. Do the selected features elegantly present your entry?
2. Is your entry intuitive and easy to use?
