**Colors:** COURSE 1 - red, blue, green, yellow, purple, orange, pink, black, white, brown, gray  
(optional/more advanced: i.e. light/dark green)

## Emotions and adjectives:

- COURSE 1 -
  - good, happy, sad, angry/mad, scared, hungry, funny, sick, tired (use in Lesson 3)
  - big, small (use in Lesson 5)
- COURSE 2 - old/young, tall/short, nice, smart, beautiful/ugly, slow/fast, strong/weak

**Basic common nouns:** COURSE 1 - city, town, street, car, house, door, store, tree, park, animal, dog, cat

**Days of the week:** COURSE 1 - Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday

**People vocab:** COURSE 1 - boy/girl, (man/woman), friend, teacher, student, classmate (focus on the regular plural forms)

**Family:** COURSE 2 - mother/father (mom/dad), little/big sister/brother, aunt/uncle, cousin, grandmother/grandfather - parents, child/children, daughter/son, granddaughter/grandson (optional i.e. for adults:, niece, nephew, mother-in-law/father-in-law, brother-in-law/sister-in-law, girlfriend/boyfriend, wife/husband - **add later in the curriculum**)

**Appearance vocab:** COURSE 2 - (tall/short), eyes, hair, glasses

**Clothing:** COURSE 2 - (tennis) shoes, sandals, socks, pants, jeans, shorts, (t-)shirt, blouse, jacket, sweater, skirt, dress

**Months:** COURSE 3 - January, February, March, April, May, June, July, August, September, October, November, December

**Ordinal Numbers:** COURSE 3 - first (1st), second (2nd), third (3rd), fourth (4th), fifth (5th), sixth (6th), seventh (7th), eighth (8th), ninth (9th), tenth (10th), eleventh (11th), twelfth (12th)...twentieth (20th), twenty-first (21st)...thirtieth (30th), thirty-first (31st)

**Regular “action verbs” present tense (& nouns that go with them):**

- COURSE 3: eat food, drink water, play a game/soccer/basketball, read a book(s), write a book/story/poem, learn English, sing songs, dance, watch TV, run, walk, swim, cook food, jump, sleep, see, clean my house, work
- COURSE 6 (irregular verbs): study English, (copy a text/words), fly, teach English, go to school, do my homework

#### **Daily routine - regular verbs and vocab:**

- COURSE 3 - wake/get up, make my bed, use the bathroom, shower, get dressed, eat/cook breakfast/lunch/dinner, go to school/work, go home, clean the house/my room, (help my mother), play..., go to bed/sleep
- COURSE 6 (irregular verbs) - brush my teeth, wash my face, do my homework, study English, watch TV

#### **Food, fruits and vegetables: COURSE 4**

- breakfast, lunch, dinner
- Fruits: banana, apple, pear, strawberry, peach, mango, papaya, lemon, lime
- Vegetables: tomato, cucumber, carrot, lettuce, avocado, onion, garlic, potato, corn, mushroom
- Basics and side dishes: bread, eggs, cheese, beans, rice, sauce
- Main dishes: salad, hamburgers, pizza, pasta/spaghetti, meat, (chicken, beef, pork), seafood (fish, shrimp)
- Snacks: french fries & chips
- Desserts: chocolate, cake/pie, sweets/candy, cookies, ice cream
- Drinks: water, soda, juice, milk(shake), hot drinks (hot chocolate, tea, coffee)

**Hobbies** (verbs and nouns): COURSE 4 - play tennis/volleyball, listen to music, go to the cinema, talk to my friends, take photos, draw/paint, ride my bike, make music/play i.e. the guitar

(review: play soccer/basketball, swim, run, dance, sing songs, read (a) book(s), write stories/poems, watch TV, cook food, learn English)

**Body parts:** COURSE 4 - head, face, ear, nose, eye, mouth, shoulder, arm, elbow, hand, finger, belly, leg, knee, foot (plural: feet), toe (Optional: lips, eyebrow(s), eyelashes, skin, nail(s))

**Verbs related to senses and body parts:** COURSE 4 - see, hear, smell, taste, touch

**School vocab:** COURSE 5 - school, classroom, teacher, pen, pencil, marker, eraser, paper, book, notebook, words, picture/photo, glue, scissors, map, backpack, clock, board, computer, chair, ball

→ School subjects: COURSE 5 - Math, English, Spanish, Science, History, Geography, Physical Education, Music, Art

→ Verb “study” & “learn”

**Words to express time:**

- COURSE 6 (future tense): tomorrow, this/next week/weekend/Sunday, in two months
- COURSE 7 (times of the day): in the morning, at noon, in the afternoon, in the evening, at night, everyday, on the weekend

**Places:** COURSE 6

- (go) home
- (go to) school, university, work
- (go to my) house

- (go to the) (city) center, (super)market, store, museum, church, library, park, cinema, hospital, pharmacy, café, bakery, bank, mall

**Occupations (& related verbs, nouns and *adjectives?*):** teacher (teach children, teach a language), doctor (help sick people), nurse (help the doctor, help sick people), dentist (fix teeths), (taxi) driver (drives), pilot (fly an airplane), baker (bake i.e. bread, cookies, cakes...) cook (cook delicious food), waiter, artisan, architect, accountant, designer, policeman, fireman, writer, painter, engineer, carpenter, secretary, lawyer, photographer, reporter, soldier, mechanic
