

Instructions for viewing the presentation on MyPlick

As you will see there are a push play buttons below the screen, and other icons. The presentation is set up to run automatically but you can pause at anytime. The icon to which the arrow is pointing will give you a **full screen view** if you click it.

- If you wish to pause when in full screen mode just push the *escape* button on your computer.

If you hold your cursor over each icon next to the slide, you will find out about all the functions, e.g. pdf version of the presentation.
