

## **STAYN' ALIVE---Activity Karibian**

## **Points of View**

As we to read the novel ALIVE, we are constantly amazed at what is required of these individuals who continue to survive in spite of overwhelming obstacles and odds. In an effort to recreate that scenario, we will have tasks we will do in class that correspond to the life saving activities that occurred in the Andes' mountains aboard the Fairchild.

The following are the rules, incentives and ways to win.

**1. Select an activity card. Each group will select an activity card which will have a classroom task matching a task that may or may not have happened on the mountain. You will then use the laptops to conduct your research.**

- a. There will be a time limit in which you must complete the task. If you do not complete the task, you and your group will “stay on the mountain, FOREVER”.
- b. If you do complete the task, you get a point for every one of your group mates

**2. Once the tasks are completed, we will have a chance round**

- a. Each member of the group will roll a die.
  - i. The players with the 2 lowest rolls becomes “injured”
  - ii. Those two roll again, the lowest roll will then “die.” If the same number is rolled, then both survive.
  - iii. Teams get 1 point for each players still alive
- b. *Catastrophe roll*: Each group will then get 1 roll with 2 dice. If a double is rolled, half of the group will die due to some catastrophe.

**3. Points will then be tallied from each of the three activities. The team with the most points will win the round and those still alive will continue for next week. Those who are dead will still be involved as “Food” for the others in the group. If no one dies in a group, that group will start with a chance roll and one may die then.**
