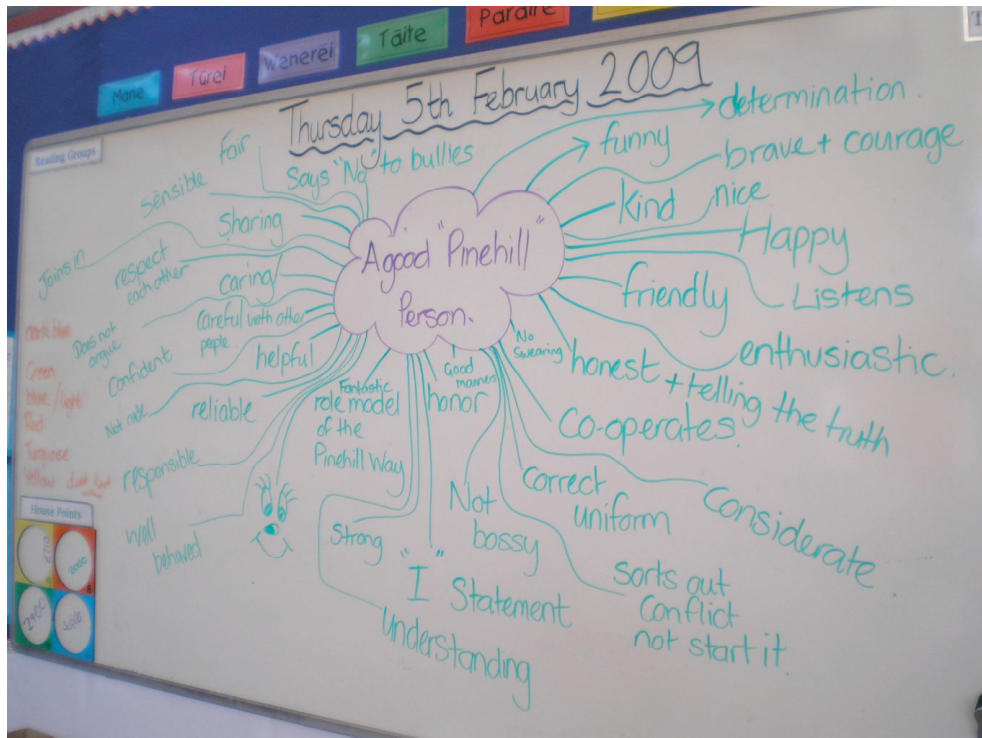
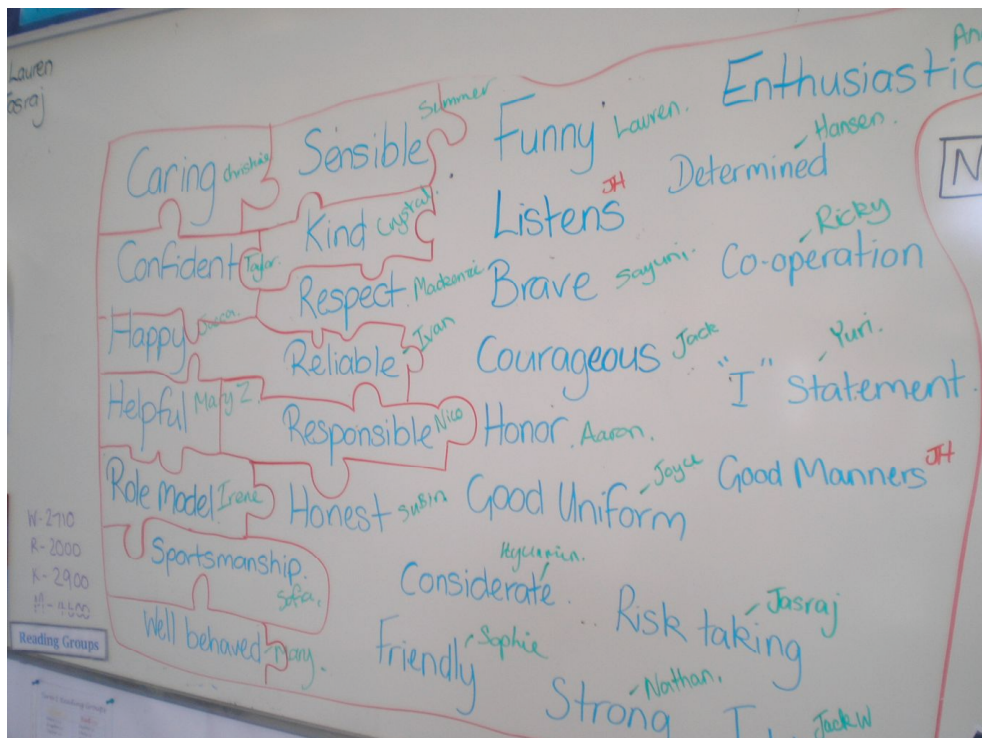


Brainstorming - "What makes a Good Pinehill Person/Leader?"

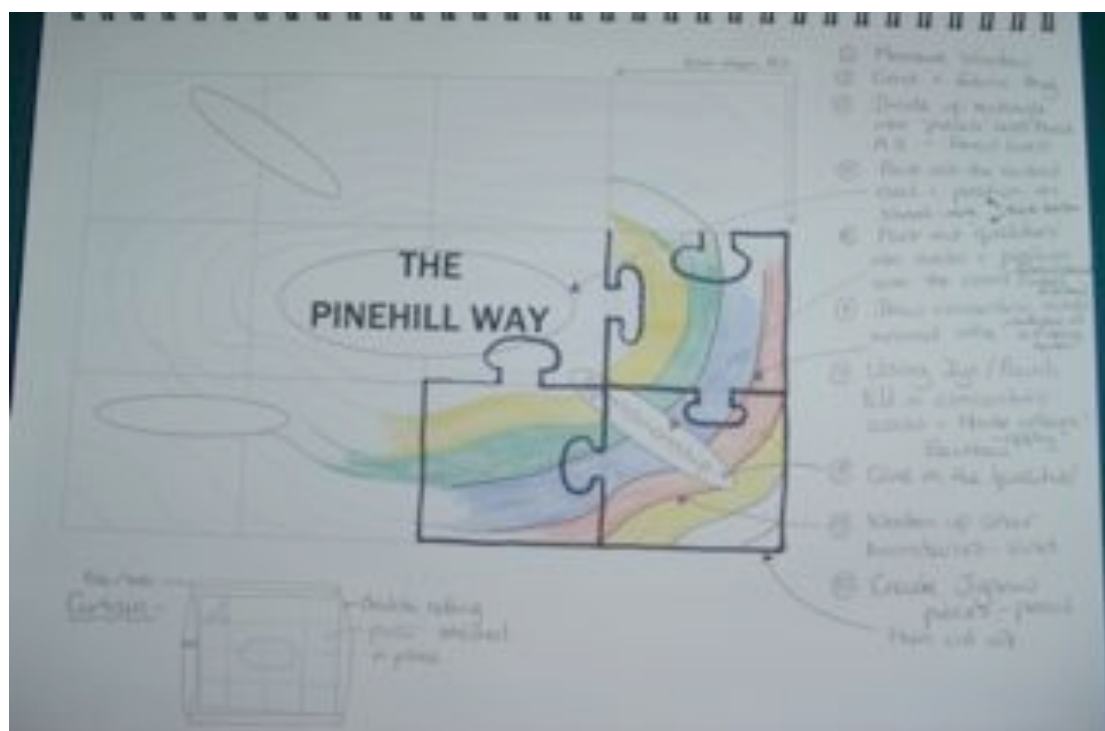


Identifying the Qualities and allocating words to be creatively typed.



During the listing of qualities a student suggested that we displayed the qualities as a jigsaw and the Pinehill Way being a completed puzzle. The students decided that the pieces are good behaviours or qualities on their own but if we put them altogether they create great students and fantastic adults

This is the design of the display based on the original jigsaw puzzle idea.



Methods of hanging the huge artwork required some creative thinking - especially as we decided to actually cut the display into "pieces"! Making a large clear plastic or netting pocket suspended from the ceiling was the most practical solution.

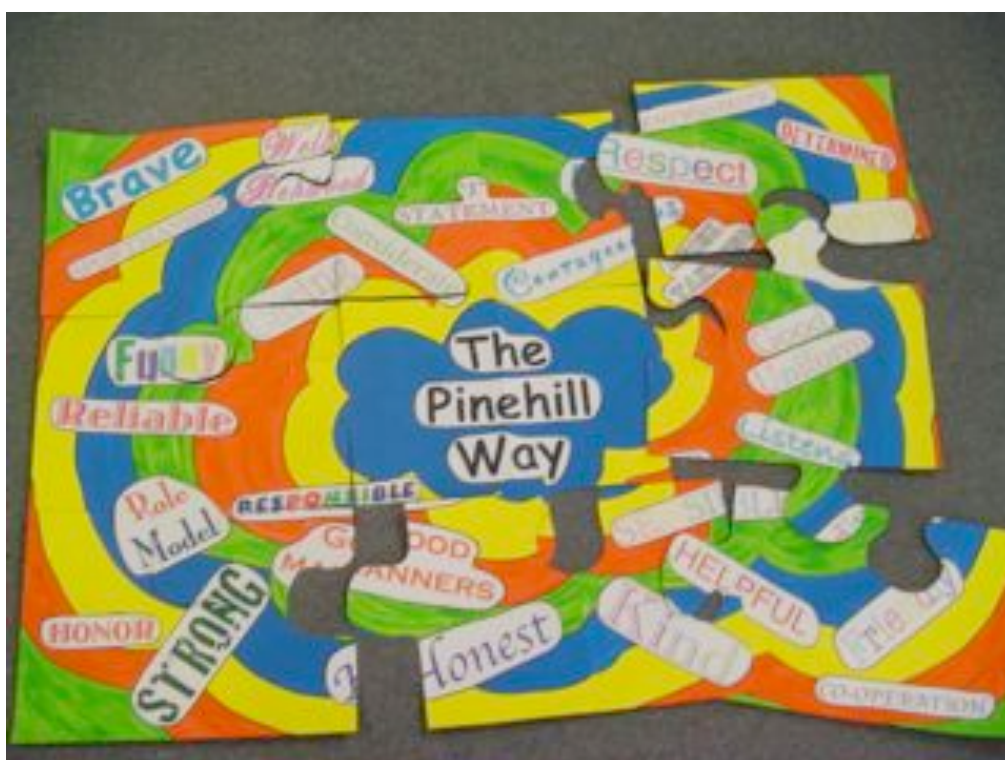
Examples of the words typed by the students using Appleworks ready for the final display.



The background of the puzzle was chosen to represent the four House groups of Pinehill. Rakino – red, Motuihe – blue, Waiheke – yellow and Kawau green.



The final artwork was photographed prior to cutting and hanging. The image was made into an A4 jigsaw as a gift to the Principal



A netting pocket was stitched around the puzzle and was suspended using hooks and a bamboo pole to refer to on a daily basis.
