INTRODUCTION

You will have fun deciding which language function is required in each situation and in matching the Spanish that represents each function.

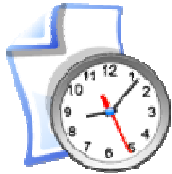
First you will go back to the course outline and look at Unit Four - 2. A-k

ACTIVITY

Look at the images provided in your Work Sheet 1. Which language functions are depicted? Using your function sheet for support, match the Spanish given in the right column. You will then practise orally a number of situations presented by your tutor.

You will read the situations described in Work Sheet 2 and decide which function is required. Again use your function sheet for support and respond to the situations. Your tutor will evaluate the responses.



ASSESSMENT

The tutor will present four directed and six oral situations. Directed situations will be corrected on the whiteboard and oral situations will be presented orally.

You will need to **learn and practise** using the Spanish given for each function. If in doubt, text a response to your tutor for some feedback. When you have the hang of it go to your text book and work through situations given in each lesson. You are on your way to success with situations.
