Kate: It **was** (BE) about a woman who **couldn't** (NOT-CAN) study when she was a child and she **didn't know** (NOT-KNOW) how to write or read. But then she **met** (MEET) a handsome man in a park who **felt** (FEEL) sorry for her and **taught** (TEACH) her to write and read and she **learnt** (LEARN) a lot of things with him and after they **married** (MARRY).

Susan: Oh, it **sounds** (SOUND) interesting. And **did you have** (YOU-HAVE) a good time?

Kate: Yes, it was great, thanks.
