

Lesson 4 Robust Vocabulary

1. **disability**—If something stops you from doing something that most people can do, you have a disability.
2. **position**—When you describe the way that a person or thing stands, sits, or lies down, you tell about that person's or thing's position.
3. **attached**—If you are attached to someone or something, you feel very close to that person or thing.
4. **assistance**—When you help someone or something, you give assistance.
5. **depend**—When you depend on someone or something, you need that person or thing.
6. **responsibility**—If you have a responsibility, there is something you have to do or take care of.
7. **frisky**—If a pet is frisky, it is very lively and playful.
8. **affinity**—If you have an affinity for something, you naturally like it.
