1. **bewildered**—When you are bewildered, you are confused and unable to understand something.
2. **evasive**—When someone tries to avoid answering a question, that person is being evasive.
3. **mull**—When you think through possible solutions to a problem, or the answer to a question, you mull over the information.
4. **startle**—If someone comes up quietly behind you and surprises you, the person may startle you.
5. **distrust**—When someone is not honest with you, you might distrust that person.
6. **witness**—If someone sees an event and can tell about it, that person is a witness.
7. **lock**—A group of hairs that hang together is a lock of hair.
8. **beneath**—If you stand under a tree, you are standing beneath the tree.
