1. **sleuths**—Sleuth are people who try to solve crimes or mysteries.
2. **host**—The host of a program introduces the guests and talks with them.
3. **statue**—A statue is a work of art, often showing a person, that can be seen from all sides. It may be made of wood, stone, bronze, or some other hard material.
4. **risk**—If you take a risk, you take a chance of harm or a bad result.
5. **responds**—If someone responds to a question, he or she is giving an answer.
6. **accurately**—When you do something without making any mistakes, you have done it accurately.
7. **encountered**—If you met someone you didn't expect to see, you encountered that person.
8. **originated**—The time when something started or began is when it originated.
9. **opponent**—When you play against someone else to win a game or contest, you are that person's opponent.
10. **impulsive**—When someone often does things without thinking, that person is impulsive.
