Chapter 9 Enrichment Options:

(Note: Each activity will be added under the "Projects" category of your overall grade and is worth 8 points.)

Option #1: Lewis and Clark Research the Corps of Discovery and prepare a summary of the journey that might have been presented to President Jefferson upon their return. Summaries should be 3-5 paragraphs long explaining the successes of the trip. Use descriptive language since the President and other easterners had no idea what the explorers had seen.

Option #2: Tecumseh Research the life of Tecumseh. Using your understanding of nationalism, write a persuasive speech that Tecumseh might have delivered to encourage other Native Americans to organize against the expanding white settlers. State a position clearly and support your position with facts, examples, and details. Why not deliver your speech to the class?

Option #3: Political Leaders Write a persuasive speech supporting or opposing the war with Britain in 1812. The purpose of your speech is to persuade listeners to agree with your point of view. Deliver your speech to the class. Then, invite students to express their own views. If there is disagreement, you might wish to debate the issue.
