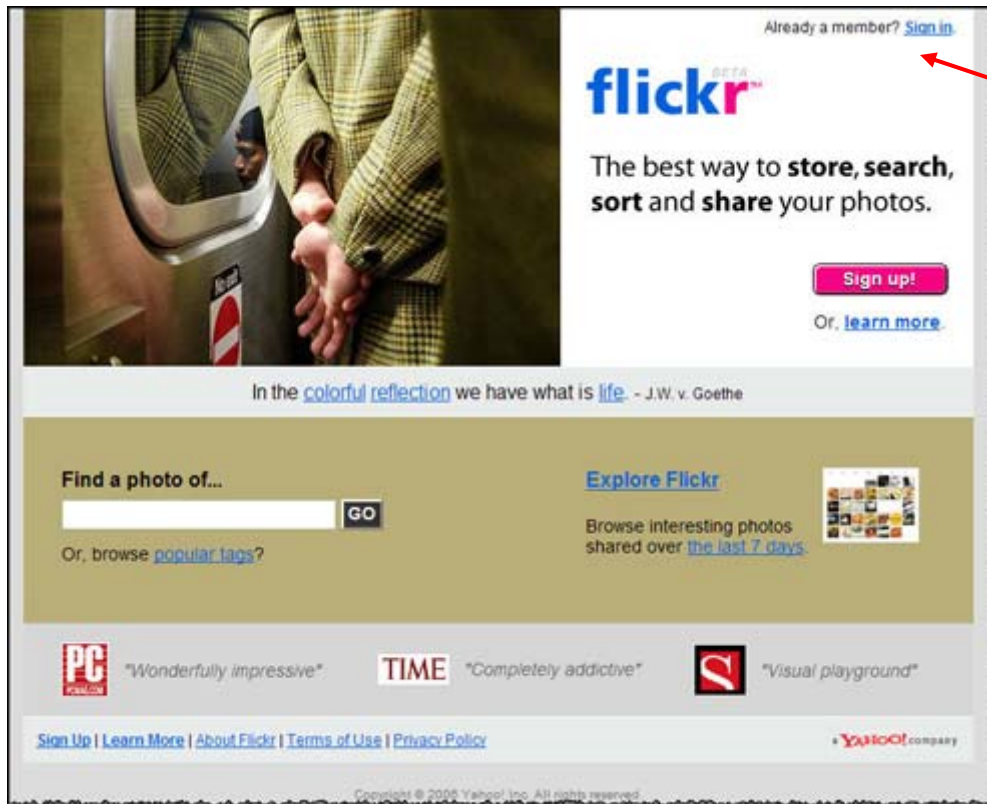
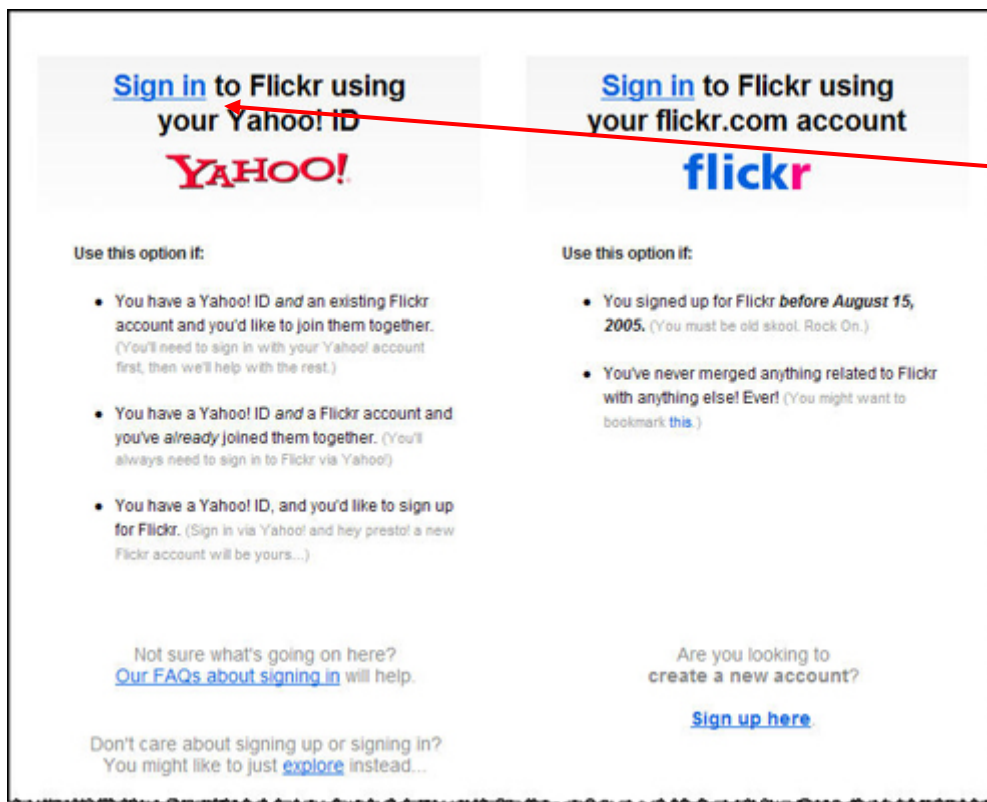


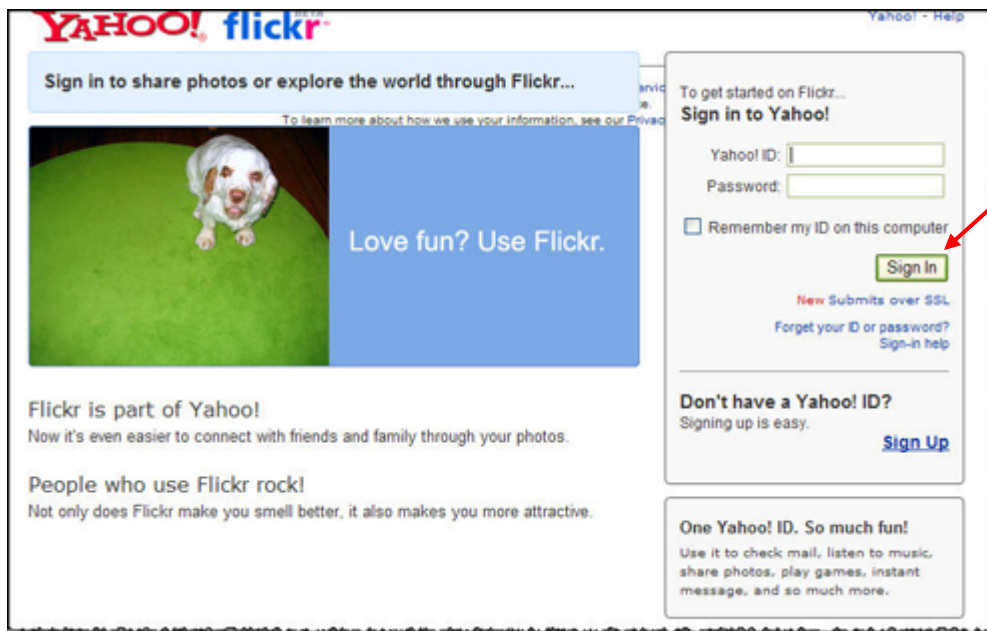
## Uploading an Image to Flickr



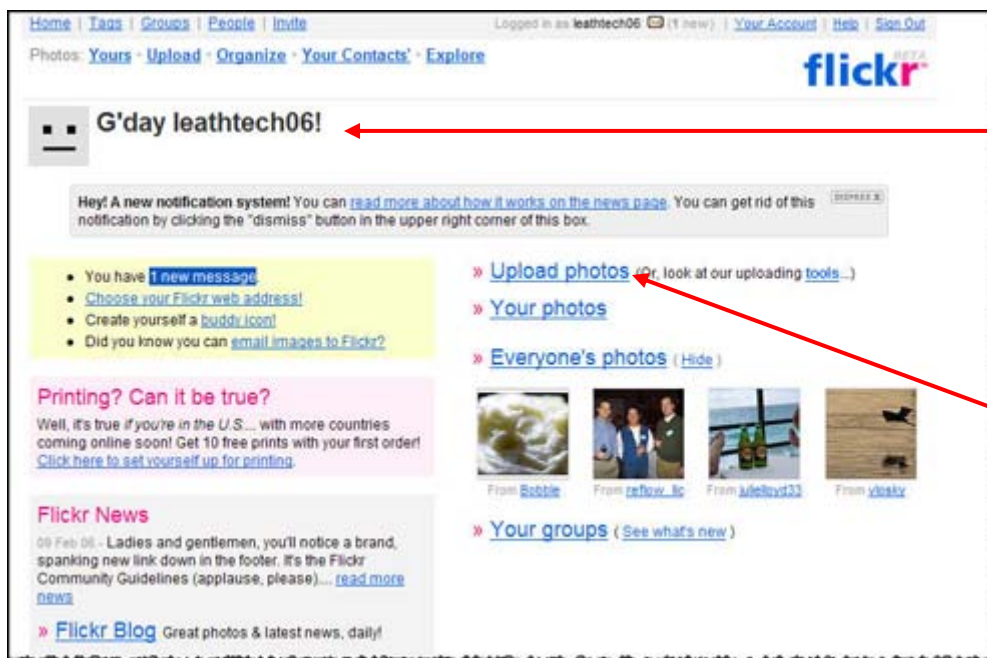
1. Go to [www.flickr.com](http://www.flickr.com)
2. Click on Already a Member? Sign in link.



3. Click the Sign in link to Flickr using your Yahoo! ID.



4. Sign in to Yahoo! Type in your Yahoo! ID and Password, and then click the Sign In button.



5. Your Flickr home page will be the first page displayed after you login. Your user name should always appear.
6. There are many different ways you can upload images to Flickr. This tutorial will focus on the standard over the Internet upload.
7. To begin uploading click on the Upload photos link.

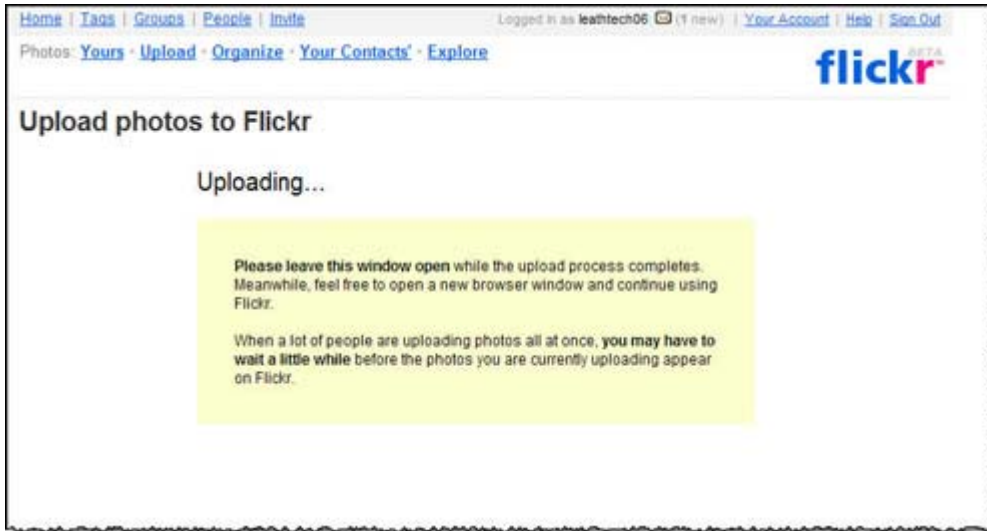

10. Notice once I find the image it appears in the 1<sup>st</sup> slot. If you wanted to upload another image you could click the second Browse... Button and select another image.

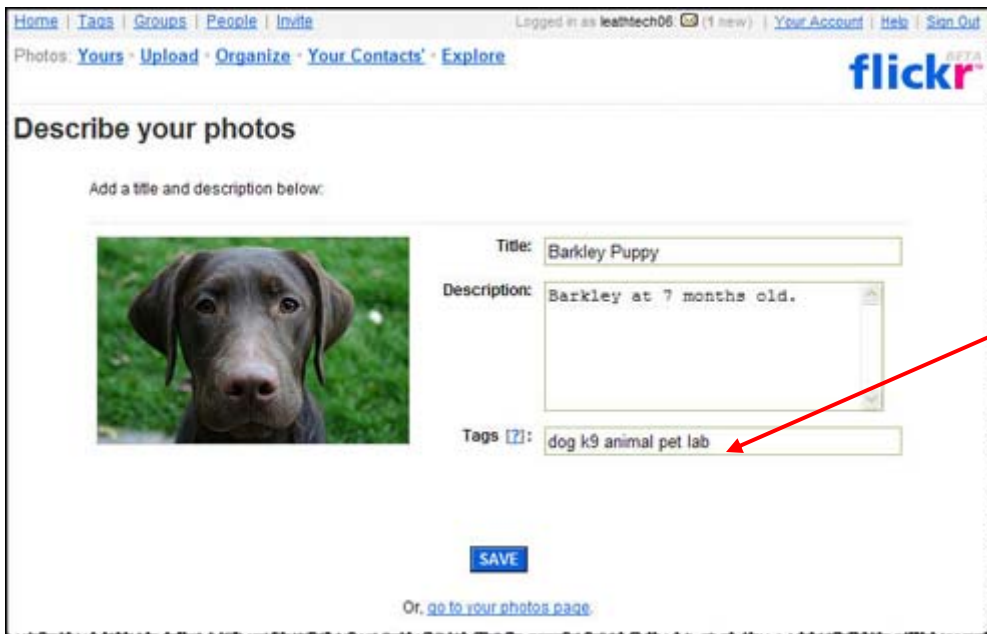
11. Before uploading the image you have the option of setting some basic picture settings. We will ignore them for now since they can be set at a later time.

12. Now Click the Blue UPLOAD button.





13. After clicking the UPLOAD button the page will change and begin uploading the image. Files normally upload quickly if you are on a high speed connection to the Internet.



14. Once your picture uploads you will be taken to a new page that allows you to add a title, description, and tags.
15. Tags are an important part of the Flickr Community, these words are what allow people to search and find your pictures. Notice the words used for the example picture: dog, k9, animal, pet, lab. If you typed any of these words into Flickr's search engine the Barkley Puppy picture would show a search result.
