

Strategy:	One Sentence Summary
Explanation:	<p>One Sentence Summary is a tool used to help students organize their thoughts and write a brief summary statement that captures the meaning of the material learned or read. One Sentence Summary is a tool that can easily indicate a student's level of understanding of material.</p>
When to use this strategy:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · To summarize new information · To compare and contrast · To describe or sequence · To show cause/effect · To show problem/solution
Ideas:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Use a One Sentence Summary to compare 2 characters in a story · To explain the steps to solve a problem · To describe the characteristics of a reptile · To show how supply effects demand
