DESCRIPTIVE:

Your paragraph is somewhat general and needs to be focused more clearly on an event or memory. I suggest focusing on the first class meeting and then on your personal meeting with Rommel. Focus on explaining his facial expressions and what he said, his gestures and movements and what they communicated. In other words, focus on explaining the interaction between him and students and him and you more specifically so readers can “see” his wisdom through his facial expressions, gestures, and words. Your metaphors are great and the dialogue you provide is also good. Overall, the structure works too. Just work on the content and support.

EXPOSITORY:

A good first draft with a clear overall structure and main idea. What you need to work on is support—you make a lot of general statements about things like “obstacles,” “journey,” “other medium,” “social problems” and so on that you need to explain in more detail. What do you mean by these general words/phrases and statements? What kind of obstacles and journeys, for example. I think you have something good to say; you just need to be more precise in how you say it.
