boomerang	a curved stick that returns after it is thrown (p. 7)
Inuit	a person or group of people who live in the Arctic, north of Canada, Alaska and Greenland (p. 12)
caribou	a large deer of northern and Arctic North America (p. 13)
ketchup	a thick, red sauce that is made with tomatoes, onions, salt, sugar, and spices (p. 13)
