Wrong: How many potatoes would you like?

Oliver had glass of champagne.

Wrong: Oliver had a glass of champagne.

Sarah gave a bicycle her son.

Wrong. Sarah gave a bicycle to her son.

Where does Santa from?

Wrong: Where is Santa from?
Or: Where does Santa come from?

**A) Where's Santa?
B) He delivers presents.**

Wrong. He's delivering presents.

Santa don't like snow!

Wrong: Santa doesn't like snow.

Santa never works on the summer.

Wrong. Santa doesn't work in the summer.

**A) Where did Santa born?
B) I don't know!**

Wrong: Where was Santa born?

**Santa didn't give nothing
last year.**

Wrong: Santa didn't give anything last year.
Or: Santa gave nothing last year.

**Last year, it was snowed
on Christmas Day.**

Wrong: Last year, it snowed on Christmas Day.

**Yesterday, it snowed very
heavy.**

Wrong. Last year, it snowed very heavily.

**Do you eat turkey on
Christmas?**

Wrong: Do you eat turkey at Christmas?

**Bob went to a walk on
Christmas Day.**

Wrong: Bob went for a walk on Christmas Day.

**Sue often eat a lot of
chocolate in December.**

Wrong: Sue often eats a lot of chocolate in December.

**I drivied home after the
office party.**

Wrong: I drove home after the office party.

**Yesterday, I weared my
new sweater.**

Wrong: Yesterday, I wore my new sweater.

**After the party, I got to home
really late.**

Wrong. After the party, I got home really late.

**Henry went home at 4
o'clock the afternoon.**

Wrong: Henry went home at 4 o'clock in the afternoon.

**How much presents are
there under the tree?**

Wrong: How many presents are there under the tree?

**How much ice-cream did
you eat yesterday?**

Right.

**How many cakes are they
on the table?**

Wrong: How many cakes are there on the table?

**Have you ever see snow
on Christmas Day?**

Wrong: Have you ever seen snow on Christmas Day?

**Last year, I haven't eaten
duck on Christmas Day.**

Wrong: Last year, I didn't eat duck on Christmas Day.

**Henry has ever been to
Scotland.**

Wrong: Henry has been to Scotland
Or: Henry has never been to Scotland.

**Do you like to listen
Christmas carols?**

Wrong: Do you like to listen to Christmas carols?

**A) Do you like some more
turkey?**

B) Yes please!

Wrong: Would you like some more turkey?

**I went to nice party on
Christmas Eve.**

Wrong: I went to a nice party on Christmas Eve.

**My children are very exciting
at Christmas.**

Wrong: My children are very excited at Christmas.

**Santa delivers presents in
night.**

Wrong: Santa delivers presents at night.

**I'm going to stay a nice hotel
in December.**

Wrong: I'm going to stay at a nice hotel in December.

**Sally stayed with she's
mother over New Year.**

Wrong: Sally stayed with her mother over New Year.

**I must lose weight in
January.**

Right.

**I want to lots of homework
over Christmas.**

Wrong: I want lots of homework over Christmas.
Or: I want to do lots of homework over Christmas.

**I don't finish my Christmas
shopping yet.**

Wrong: I haven't finished my Christmas shopping yet.

**John often listens the
radio in the evening.**

Wrong: John often listens to the radio in the evening.

Your new jeans is very nice!

Wrong: Your new jeans are very nice!

Why you get up so early on Christmas Day?

Wrong: Why do you get up so early on Christmas Day?

Yesterday, I finished to wrap the presents.

Wrong: Yesterday, I finished wrapping the presents.

I bought my sister a perfume.

Wrong: I bought my sister [some] perfume.

Rudolph likes to eat chocolate.

Right.

My father bought a Christmas tree in October.

Right.

Santa speaks English very good.

Wrong: Santa speaks English very well.

Santa have a big beard.

Wrong: Santa has a big beard.

Claire had a boiled egg for breakfast.

Right.

Santa is afraid of mice.

Right.

Bob likes Christmas cake, but I'm not.

Wrong: Bob likes Christmas cake, but I don't.

It's very cold in winter!

Right.

**A) Where's my present?
B) There is under the tree!**

Wrong: It's under the tree.

Santa can sing beautifully.

Right.
