### Date Details

1882 Chinese Exclusion Act:  
It allowed the US congress to suspend Chinese immigration for 10 years.

1931 Frederick Louise Allen:  
The wrote the book "Only Yesterday, Informal History of the 1920's". Made lasting commentary of the KKK

1910-1920 New Image & Lifestyle:  
During this time period, women were beginning to engage in behaviors and wearing styles of clothing that were different from than their parents generation.

1920 Women's Rights:  
In 1920, Washington gave women the right to vote.

1920-1933 Prohibition:  
The banning of alcohol use.

1925 Scope Trial:  
John Scope put on trial for teaching students of the Theory of Evolution.

1929 Stock Market Crash:  
The crash of the stock market cues the start of the Great Depression.
