


Making Positive Connections with Postcards

Making postcards is simple and time efficient, yet it has a big impact on increasing positive school culture. Kids love to get mail and parents love to hear about what their kids are doing well.

Directions:

1. Order postcards from a local printer. Our cost is 12 cents a card & postage is 27 cents. See the template below.
2. Explain to your staff that the purpose is to increase positive recognition for student behaviors. Cards can be sent to any student for any positive reason or the building can select a trait and send cards to those students who exemplify that trait.
3. Prior to each faculty meeting set out a card for every staff member.
4. Print several copies of all student addresses listed alphabetically.
5. When staff enter the faculty meeting they will take 2-3 minutes to write a brief positive note to a student, add the address and place in the center of the table.
6. At the end of the meeting collect all of the kids. My secretary runs them through the postage machine and we mail them.
7. Kids will talk about the cards with excitement. It is perfect refrigerator material that helps staff, students and parents connect.
