Consortium Goals:

- Improve student achievement, especially those with Limited English Proficiency, in the core content areas.
- Support districts' efforts to ensure that all staff utilizes research based curriculum, instruction, and assessment practices.

Consortium Services:

- ELL Network

This is a forum for district personnel responsible for ELL programs and instruction to discuss pertinent issues, share and explore resources, and network with colleagues. (Expenses such as mileage, meals, and substitute pay are reimbursable.)
