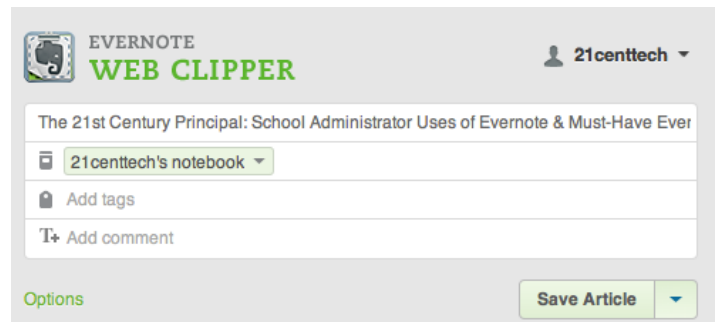

How to Clip a Web Page in Safari

1. Install Web Clipper from the Add ons page
2. Visit the website <http://goo.gl/wTyY4>
3. Once you are on the website select the  icon on the left of the address bar corner
4. If you click the triangle on the lower right corner of the dialog box you will be able to select how you wish to save to Evernote. You may want to save the entire article or you may want to save just a selection.
5. You will then be notified what you selected is being clipped and saved to your Evernote.



**Note: You may need to log in to Evernote the first time you do this. You should not have to do this every time you use it.*

How to Clip a Web Page in Firefox:

1. Install Web Clipper from the Add ons  page
2. Visit the website <http://goo.gl/wTyY4>
3. Once you are on the website select the  icon in the upper right corner
4. You will then be given 3 choices of what you want to clip, select the best option for what you would like to keep in Evernote




5. You will then be notified what you selected is being clipped and saved to your Evernote.

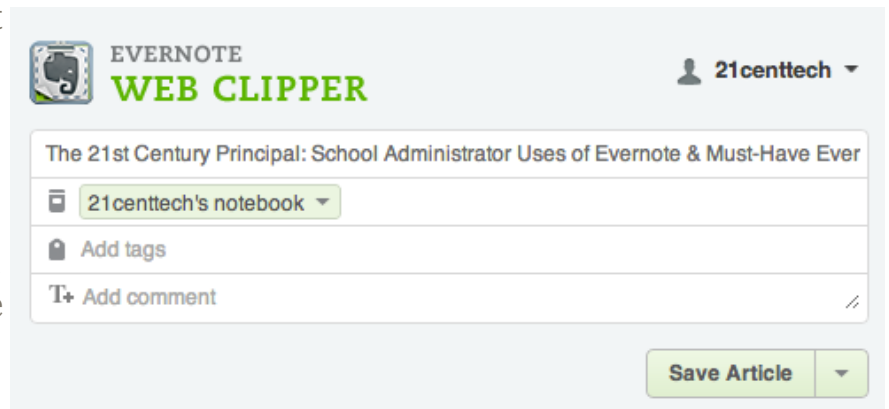

Clipping on Safari


1. Visit the website <http://goo.gl/wTyY4>
2. Under the address bar click on the words that say “Evernote” or “Clip to Evernote”

**Depending on how you named this as you created the button*

3. Sign in to your Evernote Account
4. You can now change any/all/none of the following

- a. A Title
- b. Any Tags you may want
- c. Which Notebook you want to put this article in
- d. Any text to help you remember what this relates to.

5. Click “Save”
