FIFA World Cup 2010

In the summer of 2010, we're going to watch two football games in the group stage. The games that we're going to see are South Africa vs. Mexico and Argentina vs. Nigeria. The games are going to be played in Johannesburg. We are going to take a taxi to Stockholm, Arlanda (the airport). We will arrive the 10th of June and stay to the 13th June, and then we take a taxi to our hotel room.

We are going to stay at a hotel called football fan village. The hotel is very nice, it costs about 1250kr/night. For three nights, it will be 3750 kr.

We have no discounts for our prices to flight, tickets or hotel. The currency is called rand (ZAR) and it is one penny different from the Swedish currency. Everybody has a passport and the visa is free so we don't have any extra costs to come in to the country.

The insurance is costs about 28 Swedish (kronor) for one week in Johannesburg.

When the whole trip is paid (62,182 kronor) we have 37,818 in pocket money we will spend for food and other stuffs.

12,606 money can we spend every day in Soutafrica.

Capital: Pretoria

Currency: rand (ZAR)

Inhabitants: 48 687 000

Official languages: Zulu, xhosa, afrikaans, pedi, engelska, tswana, sotho, tsonga, swati, venda and ndebele so it is totaly 11.

Climat: The climate is dry, it can rain in the late afternoons between October and april. The usual temperature is around 27° C in summer and 20° C in Winter. Freezing weather and frosts comes sometimes. Average annual rainfall varies between 600 and 800 millimeters, with the highest amounts in the summer.
