Dear Senior Class Guidance Counselor,

Faith Regional Health Services Volunteers of Norfolk, Nebraska, has established two (2) scholarships in the amount of \$2000. This sum will be made available to graduating high school seniors every year for the purpose of continuing education for a career as a registered nurse. The applicant must be accepted into a nursing school program for the fall term of 2011. The scholarship must be used for books, tuition and/or fees at an accredited school of nursing of his or her choice. The amount will be paid in two payments to the school and student. \$1000 will be paid prior to the beginning of the first semester and the remaining \$1000 will be paid at the beginning of the second semester providing a satisfactory grade average (C) has been maintained by the student. (A request will be made for the student's first semester grades.) It is our hope that this scholarship will encourage local and area students to return to this area when their education is completed.

Enclosed is the necessary application form which must be completed and returned by May 1, 2012. (Please feel free to make additional copies as needed.) The recipient will be selected by a board of five judges representing the Service Guild and the Hospital. The winner will be notified prior to graduation and must use the scholarship during the next school year, or the funds will be passed along to the alternate.

We would appreciate you informing your graduates of these two available scholarships as soon as possible or at the appropriate time.
