

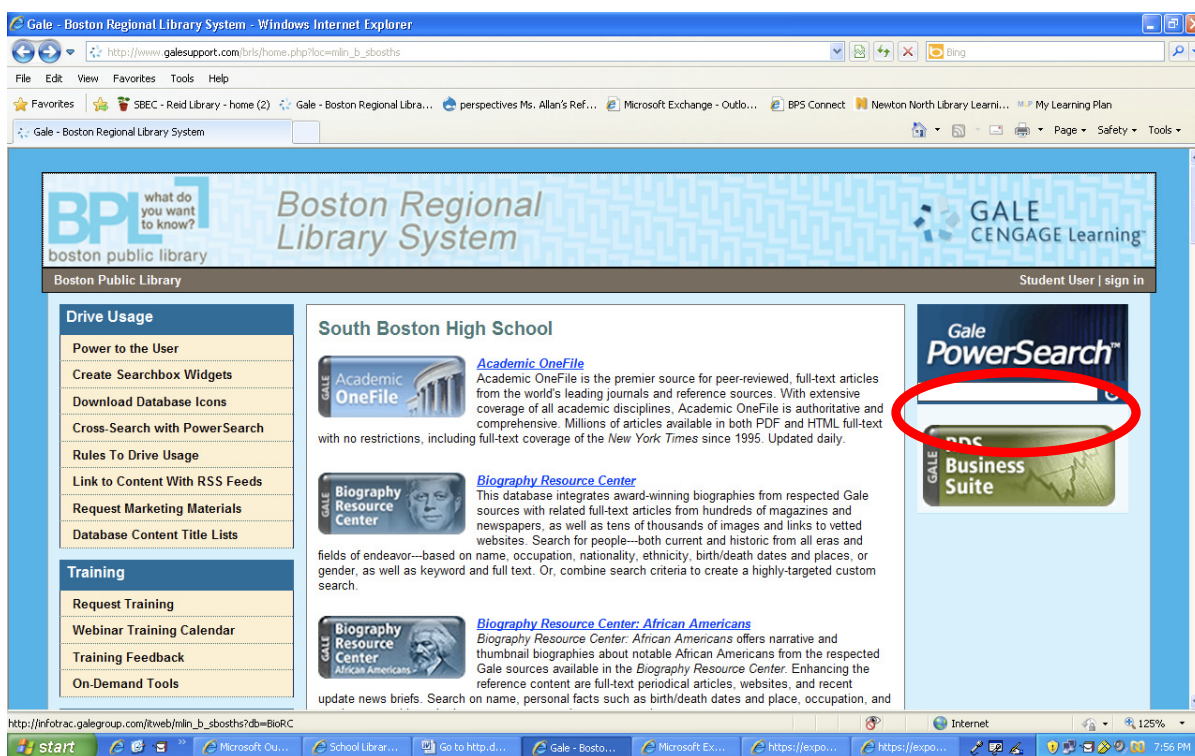
Getting There

Go to <http://sbeclibrary.wikispaces.com/> Bookmark this site – you will find it very useful for your school assignments. Enter your search on Gale Powersearch on the right hand side. The password for Gale databases is **reuben8** if you use this web site at home.

Alternative go to <http://www.galesupport.com/brls>, and pick our school from the list. Using the password: **reuben8** if you use at home

The advantage of searching through <http://sbeclibrary.wikispaces.com/> is that you do not need to enter your library card number.

Searching



Under *Gale Power Search* (upper right corner of screen) enter your search. This will search all of the Gale BPL databases and save searching time instead of several individual databases. But if you know specific database then go direct to it.

Databases



Scan through the list of databases to find the best match for your subject. If you are looking for a person, Biography Resource Center is the place to start. If you are looking for an event, like the Great Depression? Try History Resource Center US, or

International.

Search Strategy

Start with what you know: a name (*last name, first name*); a place; an event. If this does not produce useful results, look for words that describe the topic.

On the left hand side, under **Limit to**, make sure you click on **fulltext** and/or **with images** if you need it.

In the middle of the screen, under **Title, Detail** section will give you the number of words in this particular article.

On the extreme right hand side, you will find the type of the article i.e., book review, critical essay, plot summary, etc.
