6- This is a photo of the hotel. We spent our holidays there.

This is a photo of the hotel where we spent our holidays.

7- This is Laura Smith. Her daughter won the tennis championship last year.

This is Laura Smith, whose daughter won the tennis championship last year.

8- The letter hasn't arrived yet. I posted it three days ago.

The letter /which/that/Ø/ I posted three days ago hasn't arrived yet..

The holiday /when/that/Ø/ I met my girlfriend was fantastic..

If you take these pills three times a day, you'll soon feel better.

2- I couldn't meet him because he had moved.

If he hadn't moved, I could have met him

3- I can't live in the country because I can't find a job there.

If I found a job there, I could live in the country

4- Tell me your address. I might need it.

Tell me your address in case I need it

5- Unless you study hard you won't pass your exams.

If you don't study hard, you won't pass your exams

6- Visiting Israel won't be possible without a visa.

Unless you have a visa, you won't be able to visit Israel

7- I didn't pass because I didn't study.

If I had studied, I would have passed

8- Sally won't go to Nebraska because she doesn't have enough money.

If Sally had enough money, she would go to Nebraska

9- Buy some aspirins. You might need them during your journey.
