- I have always thought that being alive and inside a classroom is not enough to pass a subject, no matter which. **That will not be the case. If you do not fulfil the requirements you won't pass.**
- I also think that a subject which only has an hour a week and which is not central in your curriculum shouldn't have a big amount of homework and the truth is that, with all the problems we have had using computers, in the end most of the work you devote to your projects is being done as homework.
- I am aware of the fact that some of you have already presented your work to the classroom and two people have even handed in the printed work.
- I do not want to be unfair and I'm really concerned about inequalities.
- I think that some of you may use this holiday to catch up on work and I want you to make the most of your valuable time. That's why I came up with the idea of writing this e-mail.

Here is my conclusion:

- Only **class presentations and notebook** will be compulsory. The presentation must include a content page at the beginning and a reference page at the end. To make sure that your presentation is the result of your own work, I will keep a copy to assess it at home. You will get two marks: one for the presentation and the other for the quality of the work itself. It is also important to **calculate the time of presentation** (no more than 7-8 minutes per person). Classes will be held in TIC classroom 102 so that we don't waste so much time.
- The **attitude** in class will be **very important**. If the work is reduced to just the presentation, extra silence is required to concentrate on it.
- People who want high marks and are not sure about the high quality of their presentations can send an updated edition of the draft or/and a full written work and/or screen captures of English exercises done on-line (to which you have access at <http://www.usingenglish.com/comprehension/intermediate.html> , <http://www.usingenglish.com/comprehension/21.html> or other sections with on-line correction option in <http://extrawork.wikispaces.com/>) This last option is not only helpful for your mark in Proyecto but also to improve your English for 2 Bachillerato and selectividad. of work.
