

## Why use ICT for Assessment?

- Provides greater opportunities for Authentic Assessment
- Addresses all areas of assessment - as, of and for learning
- Enhances opportunities for deeper reflection and metacognition
- Improves student confidence and well-being (through ownership of learning)
- Increases opportunities to capture learning as it happens (especially if teacher is working with other groups)
- Student centred approach
- Provides real evidence of learning
- An effective tool to use during parent/teacher interviews and student led conferences
- Allows greater opportunities to learn and assess beyond the classroom
- Increases understanding through visual and auditory media
- With initial organisation, it makes it easier to capture student learning journeys
- Caters for more learning styles
- Supports 21st century learning
- Students who are challenged in literacy can access another tool for capturing their learning and understandings
- Able to show development and understandings over a period of time
- Makes it easier to write descriptive reports focussed on individual learning
