### Index Cards Scenario with answers

Using the index cards from the motivation activity, the teacher will assign/ or have small groups of students draw for a scenario. They will be given 5-10 minutes to discuss the scenario. They should identify the health/ safety issue, tell whether it is safe or unsafe and explain what makes it safe or unsafe. Each small group will share their findings with the class. The answers to the scenarios are below.

Scenario #	Workplace	Issue	Safe/ Unsafe	Explanation
1	Nursing Home	Allowing resident to go against doctor's orders	Unsafe	Doctor's orders are the final authority and nursing aids don't have the authority to change them. The order is there to protect the safety of the resident.
2	Day Care	Conduct fire drill and complete paperwork with documentation.	Safe	Followed procedure to make everyone aware of what would happen in the case of an actual fire drill. Documented for records.
3	Day Care	Child with bruises	Unsafe	Workers are required to report any suspicions of abuse or neglect. They should know the signs to look for, and report to superior.
4	Preschool	Buckling two children into one seat in vehicle for field trip	Unsafe	The law specifically says that each child must be buckled into their own seat belt. Injuries could result from two in one belt.
5	School	Confidentiality in the case of a student family	Safe	One student's family problem, even though she would like to have her friend there for support, is a

		problem		confidential issue, and the friend should not be present.
6	Workplace	Asking someone else to be present when talking to supervisor about a sensitive issue	Safe	You should have someone else present to hear the conversation when you confront a supervisor about a sensitive issue, in case it is ever questioned.
7	Soup kitchen	Guests at a soup kitchen who do not have shelter when weather is cold	Safe	Finding accommodations for homeless when weather is cold could be the difference between illness/ death.
8	Day Care	Text messaging a friend when you are supervising children	Unsafe	You should not be doing personal communications while at work. Taking your eye/ mind off watching children could be dangerous.
9	Juvenile Detention Center	A fight breaks out, and you attempt to break it up yourself, instead of waiting for assistance.	Unsafe	Procedure definitely states that you must call for back-up and wait until they arrive before breaking up a fight. It could result in danger for all involved.
10	EMT at accident site	Does not put gloves on while assisting a victim at the scene of a car accident.	Unsafe	Procedure definitely states that gloves must be put on before touching an accident victim, because of the possibility of spreading disease through coming into contact with bodily fluids.
11	EMT at grocery store-not working	Does not give out information regarding a car accident when someone in community asks	Safe	Confidentiality must be maintained when there is a medical situation. All health care providers are required to keep this to themselves. It provides protection for the victims and their families.
12	Day Care	Putting pictures of children you work with on the Internet without parent's	Unsafe	Putting pictures on a social networking site on the Internet is putting the children at risk. The law prohibits this. This is a privacy issue. Also, once they are

		permission		on the Internet, they cannot be removed.
13	Child Care Provider	Cutting hair of foster child without permission	Unsafe	Even foster parents are subject to many regulations, Ex. They cannot cut the child's hair or take them out of state without permission. A babysitter should not cut a child's hair, even if the child is not in foster care. These regulations are all set up for the protection of the children and their biological parents.
14	Meal Delivery Provider	Deliver meals that sat in a hot car for 2+ hours.	Unsafe	Perishable foods should never set out at room temp or warmer for more than 2 hours, 1 hour if over 90 degrees F. Could cause food poisoning.
