

## On Target

You will need 5 envelopes with drawings inside. Four will be blank or have question marks. One will have a bull's eye or target.

Pick 5 students to hold the envelopes. (You will need to know which student has the envelope with the target.) With the 5 students at the front of the class holding the envelopes, have another student in the class try to pick two envelopes. If the student picks the correct envelope (the one with the target in it), have the students holding those two envelopes step forward. If the correct one was not one that was chosen, have the two they picked step back.

If you have it down to two, ask the student to pick one. If the student chooses the right one, you are at the finish. If not, have that person step back.

If you are left with three, have another student pick two and repeat the process. To finish, you have all but the chosen one open their envelopes. Make a point about not wanting to be uncertain about the courses we need to take to prepare for our future. Have the chosen person open up the envelope to reveal the target. Make the point that we want to be on target as we plan for our future career.
