### **First Aid Simulation Situations**

#### **Activity 11-Assessment**

Give each student a first aid situation for which they must demonstrate treatment by using a classmate, doll or on a CPR dummy.

##### **Situation 1**

A child at the day care center fell while playing in the sand box. When the child fell s/he scraped his/her knee and is now bleeding.

##### **Situation 2**

While working with an elderly man in the nursing home he falls off his bed onto the floor. You are not sure what he hit on the floor, but he is conscious.

##### **Situation 3**

While assisting a young man learn to do the dishes he cuts his hand on a knife. The cut does not appear to be very deep but it is bleeding.

##### **Situation 4**

During lunch time a one year old gets a hold of too big of a piece of cheese and starts to choke on the cheese.

##### **Situation 5**

While working with cleaning chemicals at your work place, some splashes in your eyes. The container says avoid contact with eyes.

##### **Situation 6**

You are watching children at the daycare play with toys. Two children start to fight over a toy. The child who has the toy bites the other child who is trying to take the toy away.

##### **Situation 7**

You find a resident at the retirement home on the ground unconscious.

##### **Situation 8**

A student has slammed his/her hand in a door and can not feel his/her thumb.

##### **Situation 9**

A two year old child at the day care center has gotten into some cleaning supplies and you are not sure if s/he drank any of the chemicals.

##### **Situation 10**

A resident has fallen and it appears s/he may have broken his/her leg.
