The Program: Regardless of age, the Fairview Soccer camp is designed for players interested in learning and refining the fundamental skills of soccer. Our goal is to instill proper technique and understanding of the game through individualized instruction, small-sided games, and a maximum number of touches on the ball.

The Facilities: The camp will take place behind the Fairview Middle School utilizing the large practice grid, small-sided fields, and full-size match fields.

To Apply: Registrations must be post-marked by **Friday, June 19.**

Drop Off: Camp starts at 9:00am and campers should not be late. A staff member will be on duty by 8:30.

Pick Up: Campers should be picked up just after 12:00.

Break: It is recommended that campers bring a clearly marked water bottle to use individually.

Equipment Needed: shinguards, ball with name clearly marked

Ball Recommendations:

Size 3 = 7 and under

Size 4 = ages 8 to 11

Size 5 = ages 12+

9:15 - 9:45 = Technical Topics

9:45-10:45 = Stations-Skill Work

10:45-11:00 = break

11:00 - 12:00 = Small-sided games and matches

Camp Director: Matt Lane

Matt Lane completed his seventh year (93-48-7) as the boys' soccer head coach at FHS where he teaches English. The 2008 squad earned its sixth consecutive trip to the post-season and captured the D-10 Championship on its way to the PIAA Sweet Sixteen. Prior to FHS, Coach Lane was the head boys' coach (40-15-1) and assistant girls' coach at Germantown High School in Memphis, TN (1995-99). During that time the teams captured district ('95, '96, '98, '99), regional ('95), state and USA Today national championships ('99). In 1996, Coach Lane received Coach of the Year honors from the Memphis Commercial Appeal and the Coca-Cola Regional Coach of the Year Award. Lane is a 1991 graduate of McDowell High School, where he was a three-year varsity letter winner and elected to First Team All-District 10.

Coach Lane has his NSCAA State, Regional, Advanced Regional, and National diplomas.

Camp Coach: Greg Stelter

This is coach Stelter's fourth year as junior varsity head coach and assistant varsity coach for the boys' soccer program. A 2002 graduate of Girard High School, coach Stelter was a three-year letter-winner and was voted by his teammates team Most Valuable Player as a junior and senior. He is also an assistant coach for the Fairview varsity boys and girls swim teams in the winter and head coach for the seventh and eighth grade boys' soccer teams in the spring.

Coach Stelter has his NSCAA Regional and Advanced Regional Diplomas.
