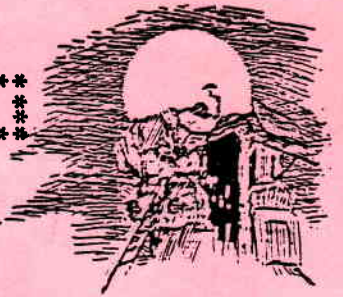

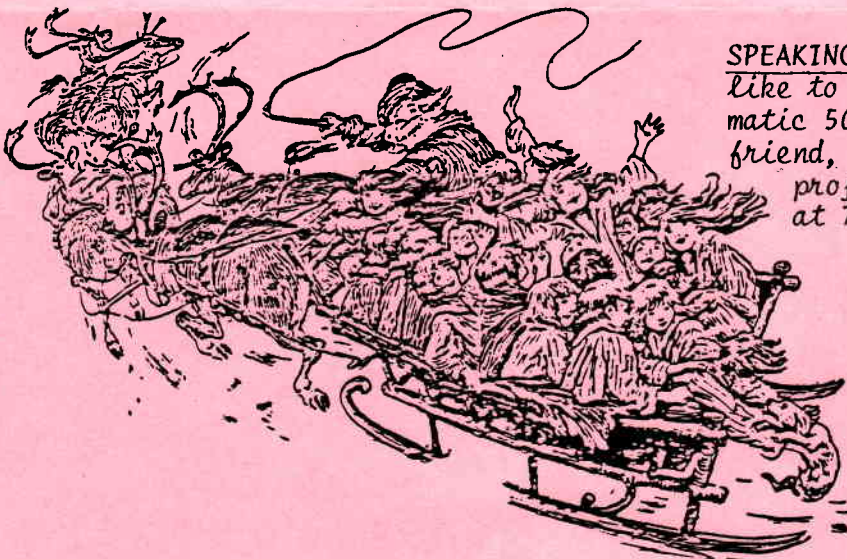
IN THE 'SPOTLIGHT': Gary Dusenberry will be in the spotlight this month.
