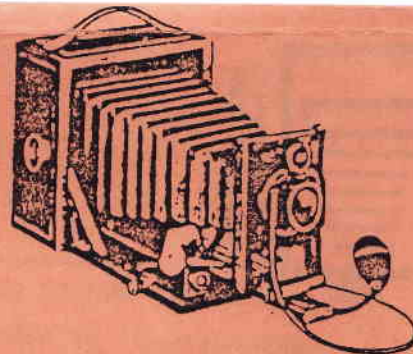

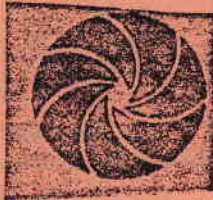

NOTES TO EXHIBITORS:

Doors will open promptly at 8 am for set-up. Parking is plentiful and close in.

Tables are large 8 footers, and are priced at \$25 for the first table and \$15 for additional tables.

While most set-up space is on the floor of the Convention Center, there are two other areas which may interest you. One is the entrance foyer, which will accommodate 15 tables, and the other is the elevated stage, which will hold ten more. Please indicate your preference, and first come will be first served. All areas of the building are beautifully lit and accessible, so that should not be a consideration. You may indicate if your preference is for the center of the main floor, or the perimeter and we will do our best to place you.

A good food service will maintain through the day what is best described as Ballpark Cuisine - not the Ritz, but not bad, either.

This show will be under the co-sponsorship of the Seaside Convention Center and Chamber of Commerce, the most active and successful group of its kind in the northwest. For those of you wishing to exhibit, we urge prompt table reservations. For those planning to stay overnight in the Seaside area, we urge prompt lodging reservations.
