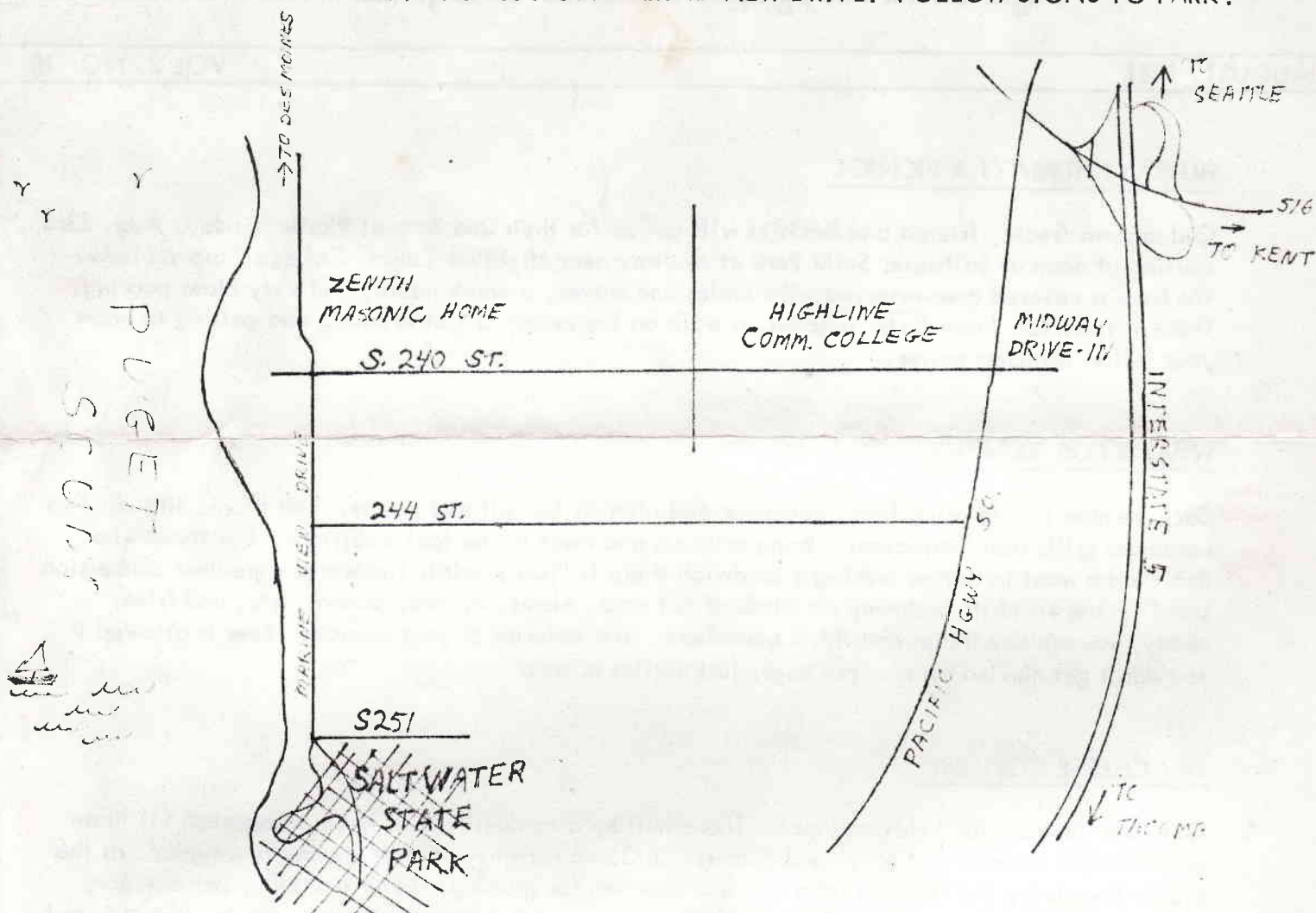

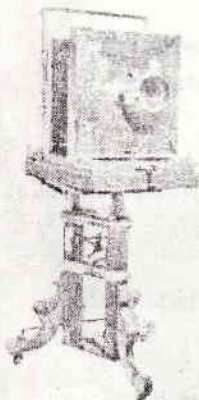
PUGET SOUND PHOTOGRAPHIC COLLECTORS SOCIETY PICNIC
