STEREO FREE VIEWING - To establish aim alignment, choose an object as far away as possible and stare at it. Leave your eyes fixed on this object. Hold this card level, and without moving your eyes, raise the paper slowly so that the two figures are in your line of sight. Don't try to focus yet. Try to notice three figures in a row. Concentrate on the center one, disregarding the two outside ones and making sure that the page is not tilted. Take time. Relax. Be patient. Your eyes are learning a new trick as they relax into the non-converged position.
