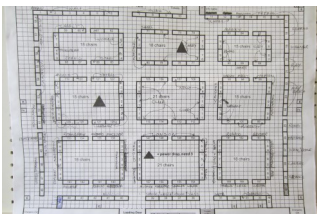

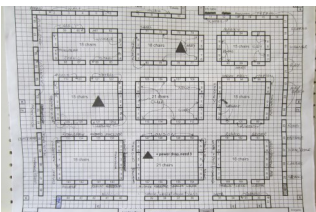

Call for Donation of Large format Leaf Shutters

Bob Peters has made a request for broken leaf type press/view camera shutters to be donated for parts to Carol Flutot who repairs leaf type shutters. Her shop is in California. Bob is not going to make any money on this, but it will allow her to continue repairing shutters. She can use Compur, Copal, Ilex, Prontor, Alphax and/or Betax, Shutter can be not working or more or less complete.

Carol provides a real service to anyone using press or view cameras and told Bob that she is not getting the donated shutters she used to get. There are no sources for repair parts except for donated shutters. Thought some of the members might have broken shutters they'd like to see be recycled for parts.

Bob will collect any shutters that turn up at the next meeting or at the show. She has done a good job on the shutters Bob has sent to her and he would like to help her out.
