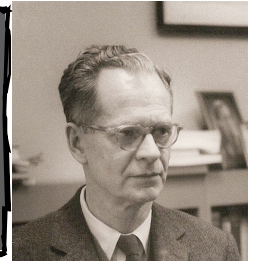




B.F. Skinner

Beyond Freedom and Dignity
And
Walden Two

Fun Fact: During World War 2, Skinner came up with a simple and effective solution as using pigeons to guide missiles by placing the pigeon inside the missile. Then a video image would be placed in front of the pigeon who would then peck at it, guiding the missile to the target. No one took him seriously.
