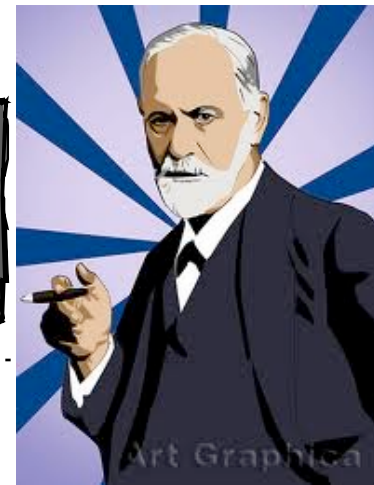

SIGMUND FREUD



Born: May 6, 1856

Died: September 23, 1939

Jewish austrian Neurologist who founded psychiatric and psychoanalytic thought. He was known for his theories on the unconscious mind and the power of repression. Freud redefined sexual desire as the primary motive for human actions (psychosexual development), which has since been modified.

Psychoanalysis is used to explain personality and behavior, and can be used to develop treatment for mental disorders. Freud completed many papers and books on his studies, including *The Ego and the Id*, *On Narcissism*, and *Three Essays on the Theory of Sexuality*.

As a medical researcher, Freud was an early proponent and user of cocaine as a stimulant and an painkiller.
