Lived: 1/11/1867-8/3/1927

Occupation: Psychologist, Professor of psychology at Cornell University, worked in structuralism pioneer Wilhelm Wundt's lab

Contribution: Pioneered use of introspection as a window into patient's minds and conscious thoughts/experiences; through careful exploration, he supported structuralism (idea of the mind made up of smaller components, not one whole system)

Literature: Editor of *Mind* and *American Journal of Psychology*

His brain was donated (and is stored) in the Cornell brain collection.
