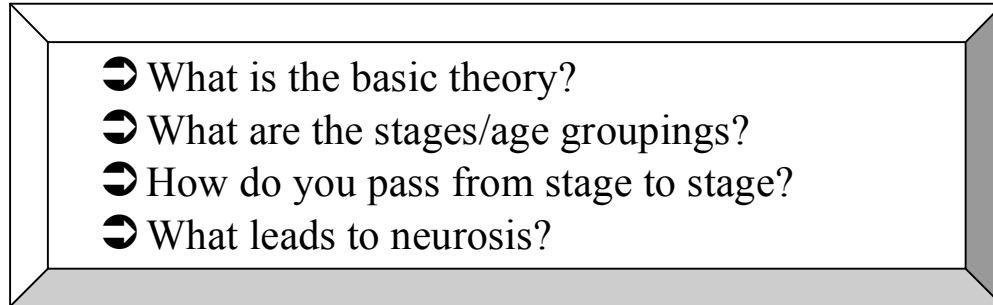


DEVELOPMENT OF PERSONALITY

Directions: In your groups, you are to try to understand the key elements of ONE particular personality theory. Read through the information sheet and/or the relevant textbook pages. As you read, consider the following:



After you answer those questions, you must design a poster about your theory. Your poster should meet the following criteria:

1. Answer the questions above in SHORT bulleted points – NO lengthy sentences
 2. Focus on VISUAL learners. Draw pictures, use symbols, creatively use color to get your point across to the audience
 3. Must be nice & neat – and be easy to read from across the room
 4. Show one example of neurosis occurring and how your theorist would explain.
- After completing posters, you will present your findings to the class. Each group member should speak. Please focus on explaining the theory and not reading from your worksheets or poster.
 - Each presentation will be graded using the attached rubric. Be sure to look closely at the rubric as you plan, create and prepare your work.

Each student should turn in a rubric prior to completing your in-class presentation. Your name, group members and assigned topic should be completed when you turn in your rubric.
