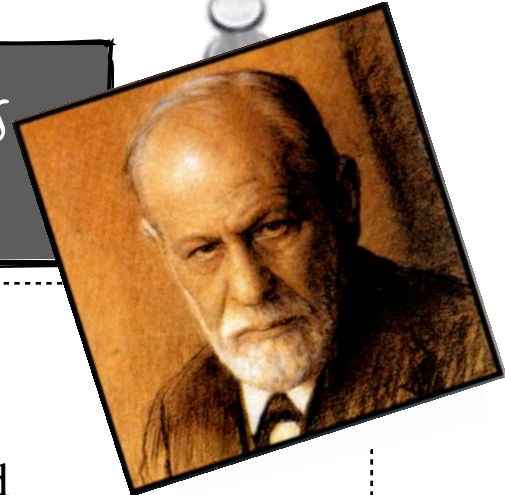

Occupation: Psychiatrist

Contribution: He developed ideas about the unconscious mind, or how people's unconscious thoughts affected conscious actions. He was noted for his contributions to psychotherapy as well; most of his theories have been disproved, but certain

major work: The standard edition of the complete psychological works of Sigmund Freud. It includes 24 volumes of his original writings, translated from German.
